**PS. NORMAN AND PS. BARBARA MILLER, AUSTRALIA**



They founded the Centre for International Reconciliation & Peace as a para-church ministry in Australia. Norman is an Aboriginal artist and

businessman while Barbara is a writer, teacher, psychologist and sociologist. The Millers hosted many International conferences including one in the Canberra Parliament House in 2004 and are also working towards revival and transformation in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island Communities.

**PS. MICHAEL MAELIAU, SOLOMON ISLAND - PACIFIC**



He is one of the founders of the All Pacific Prayer Assembly (APPA) also known as the Deep Sea Canoe Movement, in the Pacific. He is also the founder of the Aroma Bible College

in the Solomon Islands. A very profound indigenous leader and prophet who was instrumental in bringing God's people together from all islands of the Pacific as watchmen of the Lord's army. Author of the Deep Sea Canoe.

**PS. ENOKA GOHA, NEW CALEDONIA (FRENCH)**



He established a Spiritual School of Ministry for the youth and families called De La Vie in his French Speak-

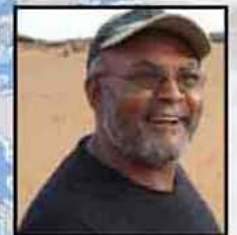
ing island of New Caledonia. A prominent leader for the youth of his nation. He is also a writer and an influential speaker in many biblical and prayer seminars in his nation.

Author of the Covenant of the First People Canada, a historic Treaty between First Nation, Inuit and Metis people in Canada. Kenny was raised in the Cree community of Mistissini Lake, Quebec and is a former Deputy Grand Chief of the Grand Council of Crees, of Quebec.

**PS. AYJAY JANTJIES, SOUTH AFRICA**



He is a descendant of one of the first people nation of South Africa called the Khoi Khoi. He is the founder of the ministry Khoi Heritage Foundation Prayer Network which includes youth, business, social and other affiliations. He is very serious in his commitment to the mandate of the Khoi people.
