Their ministry has a strong focus on bringing Australia to the place where we can be presented as a sheep nation to Jesus on Judgment Day i.e. that it will be a nation of holiness, righteousness and justice and that it will stand with Israel when the armies of the world march against it. They have the mandate of Jer 1:10 of pulling out what is foundationally not of God and building on Godly foundations.

Ps 24:7 conferences aim to open the gates of our nation to the King of Glory and close the gates to what is not of Him. They believe God has called them to prepare the way for His soon coming return and be a voice for His Kingdom. Barbara is also a writer, teacher, psychologist & sociologist and Norman is an Aboriginal artist and businessman. They founded The Centre for International Reconciliation & Peace as a parachurch ministry. The Millers planted a church in Cairns, Australia in 1996 & set the Centre up in 1997.

They took the spiritual breakthrough anointing of Jesus as the rider on the white horse and the ANZAC 800 Lighthorsemen to Israel with a tour of 21 Aussies and Kiwis in 2010 for the 93rd anniversary of the Battle of Be'er-Sheva and a tour through battle sites and the places Jesus walked. A set of DVDs is available on this. They were part of the honouring at Yad Vashem holocaust museum in Israel in 2010 of Aboriginal William Cooper for his protest in 1938 against Kristallnacht.

Through the Centre for International Reconciliation and Peace the Millers have hosted 24/7 conferences in Cairns 2003, Parliament House Canberra 2004, Uluru 2005, Sydney 2006, Bendigo & Melbourne 2007, Cairns 2009 and Parliament House Canberra 2010.

Ps Norman and Ps Barbara are the leaders of the Bethany Gate Australia under JHOPFAN and hosted the Bethany Gate & All Pacific Prayer Assembly of 2,000 people in Cairns May 2006. They were the founding national co-ordinators for the International Day of Prayer for the Peace of Jerusalem under Eaglewings USA.

They lead a team of Australians to Israel each September and have ministered in England, Canada, the USA, Zimbabwe, Israel, Turkey, Guatemala, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, NZ, PNG, Solomon Is & the Torres Strait Islands. They have produced a video: "Reconciliation - Transforming Nations, An Account of Prophetic Acts of Reconciliation between Britain & Australia 1997-1999".

Part of the vision of the Centre is: To be a prophetic endtime church without walls & a house of prayer for all nations & Israel and to Raise Up the Tabernacle of David - 2 Cor 5:18-19, Isa 56:7, Isa 62:6-7, Amos 9:11.

Guest Speakers

Rev Dr George Annadorai - was ordained within the Assemblies of God (Singapore). He pioneered a church called the Lord's Family Church - a church he both founded and pastored from 1988-2002. He served on the national committee of the unity movement in Singapore amongst the churches called "Love Singapore" between 1995 - 2007. It was through this movement that Ps. George Annadorai came to "Love...Singapore". Ps. George Annadorai (apostle) was received as a member of the "International Coalition of Apostles" in 1998. Currently Ps. George serves as a committee member in two national initiatives - national prayer alliance and together in transformation. When not in Singapore Ps. George devotes half his time (6 months in a year) to serving the nations in the Asia-Pacific region, including the nation of Israel. He has led many prophetic prayer journeys including retracing the path of the Spice Route, Silk Road and Incense Trail to Jerusalem. He has been a key leader of the Golden Gate at the All Nations Convocation Jerusalem for many years and has recently been working with Holocaust survivors in Israel to bring them the love of God.



Ps Noel Mann - and his wife Dianne have the oversight of Zion Christian Ministries that has had a mandate to pray for Israel and a call to the nations in prophetic intercession. For around 20 years they have led delegations from Australia to the All Nations Convocation Jerusalem until handing this ministry over to the Millers in 2005. They still do strategic intercession in Australia and overseas and Noel spends considerable time sitting at the feet of Jesus. Ps Noel will speak on "The Queen of Heaven".

Convocation Vision

1. To proclaim the government of Australia is on the shoulders of Jesus (Isa 9:6-7) & the Lion of the Tribe of Judah over Parliament House & our nation (Rev 5:5)
2. To proclaim "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven" for Australia (Mt6:10) as nations are judged, not just people (Mt 25:31- 46)
