Price: \$5,000 plus (not confirmed) Price includes airfares, departure taxes, excellent 3 star accommodation, breakfasts, dinners, tours and tips. Not included – travel insurance and lunches.

Group leaders free if they bring a group of 10 others.

A land price will be provided for those joining us from other nations who want to organise their own travel

Visas: not required for Australians and New Zealanders.

Pastors reference required with contact details of pastor provided.

Medical certificate required re fitness to travel if over 65.

Travel insurance mandatory.

Purpose of tour:

* to follow in the steps of the ANZACS in particular the 800 Lighthorsemen who took the wells of Be'er Sheva on Oct 31, 1917 from the Turks and Germans after a concerted battle fought by the Allies (British, Scottish, Australians, New Zealanders, South Africans and Indians). Christians from these nations are invited to be a part of the tour.

* to attend the ANZAC memorial service at Be'er-Sheva on Oct 31, the 93rd anniversary of the 800 lighthouse charge.

* to flow in reconciliation with Christian Turks and Germans joining us on the tour.

* to bring a spiritual breakthrough anointing to release in support of Israel and God's plans for it.

* to pray in the sites that Abraham built altars.

* to pray in the places that God made covenant with Abraham

* to pray in the places that God spoke to Hagar re Ishmael

* to pray at Hebron where Isaac and Ishmael buried Abraham

* to pray at Be'er-Sheva the first place of a covenant between Jew and Gentile and thus a place of reconciliation

* to pray at Mt Carmel where the altar of the Lord was restored.

* to pray at the Valley of Armageddon.

* to pray on the borders of Israel with Egypt, Gaza, Jordan, Syria and Lebanon and to pray through the West Bank as we travel by bus.

* to pray in the places where Jesus walked and ministered, was born, grew up, was crucified, resurrected and ascended.

* to meet with, hear and worship with anointed Messianic Jewish, Christian Arab and other Christian leaders the length and breadth of Israel.

* to have a fresh personal encounter with the Lord and come back renewed and revived. An opportunity for re baptism in the River Jordan.

* To get an appreciation of the Jewish roots of the Christian faith.

* to have some fun swimming with dolphins at Eilat on the Red Sea, to float in the Dead Sea, to have a boat ride on the lake at Galilee, to swim in the Mediterranean Sea at Tel Aviv and to have some time shopping for gifts at the Arab and Jewish markets.

Sun 24 Oct

Arrive - rest or tour depending on time. Tour briefing. Overnight Jerusalem.

Mon 25 Oct

Jerusalem tour – Wailing Wall, Christian Heritage Museum, Christchurch, Arab, Jewish & Armenian quarters, Via Dolorosa, Church of the Holy Sepulche, Upper Room, where David had his tabernacle & the ark, Mt Moriah, Temple Mount, the place the third temple furnishings are being made, Church of the Pater Noster, Golden Gate. Overnight Jerusalem.

Tues 26 Oct

Jerusalem tour – Visit Jerusalem House of Prayer for all Nations (JHOPFAN) on Mt of Olives, Mt Scopus cemetery where ANZACS buried, Garden of Gethsemane, Garden Tomb, Bethany, maybe Rachel's tomb. Visit to Bethlehem, the Church of the Nativity & a service at a local church. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Wed 27 Oct

Yad Vasham visit for whole morning. Hebron & Bethel, Ein Gedi, Dead Sea with time to swim. Overnight at Dead Sea.

Thurs 28 Oct

Be'er Sheva – meet with Municipality of Be'er Sheva representatives, visit school hit by missile, Abraham's well, war museum, extensive prayer Tel Be'er Sheva, the place of God's covenant with Abraham in Gen 15, the place where God changed Abram and Sarai's names, Gerar, Be'er LaHair Roi. Overnight Be'er Sheva and nearby.

Fri 29 Oct

Gaza-Beersheva line and places where ANZACS fought, following the steps of the 800 lighthorsemen. Night meeting with local believers. Overnight Be'er Sheva and nearby.

Sat 30 Oct

Day trip to Eilat on the Red Sea. See Dolphin Reef and swim with dolphins or on beach, see Underwater Observatory. Service with local congregation. Pray on border with Egypt. Visit Wilderness Tabernacle. Overnight Be'er Sheva and nearby.

Sun 31 Oct

Be'er Sheva - Anzac service, cemetery, Allenby's statue, Turkish railway station, Memorial to Allies, Park of the Australian soldier and ANZAC museum. Visit Sjeridot, Ashkelon and Ashdod. Pray on border with Gaza. Night meeting with local believers. Overnight at Ashdod.

Mon 1 Nov

Good Samaritan Inn, Jericho, Megiddo, Tel Megiddo, extended prayer at Valley of Armageddon, Nazareth, Haifa, extended prayer at Mt Carmel. Meet local congregation. Overnight at Haifa.

Tues 2 Nov

Boat ride on Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, Tabga, Mt of Beatitudes, Caesarea, Golan Heights, Semakh (800 lighthorse), Safed, pray on borders with Syria and Jordan. See Galilee Experience show. Overnight at Tiberius.

Wed 3 Nov

Masada, Mt Tabor, possibly Cana and then opportunity for baptisms in Jordan River. Overnight at Tiberius.

Thus 4 Nov

Tel Aviv/Yafo (Jaffa) see sites eg Bat Yam. Pray at Rishon Lezion and on the border with Lebanon. Visit Tel Dan and Nimrod Castle. Night meeting with local congregations. Overnight Tel Aviv.

Fri 5 Nov

Tel Aviv - free day to spend how you wish - to rest, pray, review the trip, shop for presents, enjoy beach, coffee and restaurants. Overnight Tel Aviv.
