




Take part in the once in a lifetime 100th anniversary commemoration of the courageous charge of the Australian lighthouse at Beer Sheva and honour all who fought including the brave Allied forces under Britain. A statue to the strategic role of NZ fighters and an ANZAC Museum will be opened and you can visit the Park of the Australian Soldier and attend all ceremonies including the re-enactment of the charge by the Australian Lighthouse Association (ALHA). This charge opened the way for the freeing of Jerusalem from the 400 year rule of the Ottoman Empire and the establishment of a Jewish Homeland.

We are not celebrating war but are celebrating the fulfilment of Biblical prophecy. (Amos 9.14-15; Ezek 37:10-14)

A key reason for this tour and the Sons of Abraham conference which is part of it is responding to a dream and vision by Ps Barbara Miller that we need to come into Israel through the brothers, Jew and Arab, and work for peace (shalom and salaam) between believers in Messiah. ABOUT YOUR HOSTS



Pastors Norman and Barbara Miller's ministry has a strong focus on reconciliation, justice, prayer and worship. Norman is also an Aboriginal artist and Barbara is a mediator and author. They founded the Centre for International Reconciliation & Peace Inc. as a para-church ministry in 1997 after planting a church in Cairns, Australia in 1996. It is called Tabernacle of David. From 2005-2012, they were the leaders of the Bethany Gate under the Jerusalem House of Prayer for All Nations and co-hosted the Bethany Gate & All Pacific Prayer Assembly of

over 2,000 people in Cairns in May 2006 timed to commemorate the 400th anniversary of the proclamation by Ferdinand de Quiros over the Pacific of "the South Lands of the Holy Spirit".

They have ministered in Israel, Turkey, England, Canada, the USA, Zimbabwe, Guatemala, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, NZ, PNG, Vanuatu and Solomon Is and have hosted yearly Psalm 24:7 conferences in Australia. Norman and Barbara led an ANZAC/Lighthouse team of 14 Australians and 7 New Zealanders to Israel in 2010 to commemorate the Oct 31 events in Beer Sheva. They laid wreaths at the newly completed statue to the NZ Mounted Rifles at Ben Gurion School in Ness Ziona. This commemorated the battle of Ayun Kara.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 TUESDAY 17TH OCTOBER 2017

Arrive Tel Aviv airport @ Ben Gurion on CX flight 675 at 7:40am.

Meet and assist. Meet your guide and start your touring.

Ness Ziona, see statue to NZ Mounted Rifles Ramleh Cemetery where ANZACS are buried.

Rishon LeZion, visit a local pastor and see tribute to NZ re battle of Ayun Kara.

See apology in Rishon LeZion Archives re Arab village of Surafend by our ANZAC Christian tour of 2010.

Overnight: Tel Aviv

DAY 2 WEDNESDAY 18TH OCTOBER 2017

Visit places where Abraham built altars - Shechem (Nablus) and Beth El (Ramallah).

Beth El also place of Jacob's dream, a stairway to heaven.

Shiloh, the site of the Tabernacle when the Israelites arrived in the Holy Land.

Beit El, a Jewish community where the Yeshiva operates the Arutz Sheva news website which operates out of studios here.

Overnight: Tel Aviv

DAY 3 THURSDAY 19TH OCTOBER 2017

Tel Aviv Prayer Tower.

Afternoon with Mt Carmel pastor. The prophet Elijah had his famous encounter with the prophets of Baal here.

Haifa ANZAC cemetery and see picturesque sights, hanging gardens and beaches.

Overnight: Haifa

DAY 4 FRIDAY 20TH OCTOBER 2017

Nazareth village recreates the Nazareth Jesus lived in and his parables come to life.

Galilee, the site of much of Jesus' ministry and miracles.

Cana where Jesus performed his first miracle.

Megiddo, also called Armageddon, Australians fought here.

Overnight: Tiberias

DAY 5 SATURDAY 21ST OCTOBER 2017



Enjoy a boat ride on Lake Galilee.

Capernaum, Jesus lived here and preached in the synagogue, see Peter's house.

Tabgha, where Jesus performed the miracle of the loaves and fishes and the site of his 4th resurrection appearance.

Mt of Beatitudes where Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount.

Overnight: Tiberias

DAY 6 SUNDAY 22ND OCTOBER 2017

Experience a tour of the Golan Heights with a view of the Syrian Israeli border and an explanation of the Sykes-Picot agreement that still holds in the area today!

Pray at/near border with Lebanon and Syria.

Mt Hermon, site of God's covenant with Abraham, Psalm 133 refers to it.

Tel Dan - Israel was described as Dan to Beersheba as Dan was the northern most of the 12 tribes.

Banias/Caesarea Philippi. The great confession and the transfiguration both occurred nearby (Matt 16:13).

Overnight: Tiberias

DAY 7 MONDAY 23RD OCTOBER 2017

Baptism in Jordan River. An opportunity to be re-baptised in this famous place.



Belvoir Castle, a Crusader fortress.

Semakh (Tzemach) another successful Lighthouse charge.

ALHA event at Sea of


Galilee 3pm.

Allenby Bridge named after General Allenby who led the Battle of Megiddo.

Pray at/near border with Jordan.

Transfer to Jerusalem

DAY 8 TUESDAY 24TH OCTOBER 2017

Efrat or Jerusalem, meet with Centre for Jewish-Christian Understanding and Cooperation.

Hebron where Abraham built an altar, Tomb of Patriarchs and Mamre, place of covenant.

Mt Moriah (Temple Mount) where Abraham was prepared to sacrifice Isaac, site of Solomon's Temple and crucifixion of Jesus, place of covenant.



Garden of Gethsemane (if time permits) where Jesus prayed and was arrested.

Yad Vashem – visit the William Cooper Plaque

in the research building (subject to time constraints and confirmation).

Christchurch Heritage Museum, first Protestant church in Middle East.

ALHA Lighthouse event Jerusalem late afternoon/early evening.

Overnight: Jerusalem

& DAY 11 FRIDAY 27TH OCTOBER 2017



Overnight: Jerusalem

DAY 12 SATURDAY 28TH OCTOBER



Visit pastor in Bethlehem, Jesus' birthplace & see sights. Golden gate where Jesus entered on Palm Sunday and where Messiah will enter.

Western wall, last remnant of holy temple, pray at the wall.

Via Dolorosa, retracing the steps of Jesus to the crucifixion.



Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the two holiest sites in Christianity - the site where Jesus was crucified known as Calvary or Golgotha, and Jesus's

empty tomb, where He was buried and resurrected. The Garden Tomb is an alternative location.

Arab markets (allow shopping time)

Armenian Quarter (allow shopping time)

Mt of Olives - Jesus taught the Lord's prayer here, wept over Jerusalem and this is the site of his ascension and second coming. The British defeated the Turks here Dec 1917 so no fighting occurred in Jerusalem itself before the triumphant entry of the Allies with Allenby walking, reminiscent of Jesus entering on a donkey Palm Sunday. ANZACS accompanied him.

DAY 13 SUNDAY 29TH OCTOBER

Following JNF ANZAC Trail, about 100 kilometres long, which retraces and commemorates the route the ANZAC horsemen took when they liberated Beer Sheva.

ANZAC Memorial in Be'eri Forest.

ANZAC Sign at Tel Gamma, Gerar (Wady es Sheriah).

Besor Dam built by ANZACs.



Besor park (Eshkol National Park Shellal) Ashkelon - At Shellal ANZAC troops discovered during the World War I Second Battle of Gaza a beautiful floor mosaic

depicting a variety of animals, part of the ruins of a Byzantine church. The mosaic is now displayed in the Australian War Memorial in Canberra.

Golda Park (Bir Asluj).

Turkish Patish Ruins.

Overnight Arad Guest House.

DAY 14 MONDAY 30TH OCTOBER

Visit pastors in Beer Sheva and Bible House.

Pray at Tel Sheva the place of the first covenant or peace treaty between Jews and the Philistines, first Abraham and then Isaac made it with Abimelech.

Beer LaHair Roi (if located) where God saw Hagar and heard the cries of Ishmael.

7pm Combined Worship Service at Yeshua's Inheritance congregation Beer Sheva.

Overnight: Arad Guest House

DAY 15 TUESDAY 31ST OCTOBER

Beer Sheva commemorations. Service at Commonwealth Cemetery & Turkish Memorial.

Opening Ceremony of ANZAC Museum.

Tel Sheva (Tel el-Saba) to see battlefield & for Ceremony by NZ Embassy.

Opening NZ Monument.

12md Join ALHA as they salute the Kiwis.

Re-enactment of Charge by ALHA.

Park of the Australian Soldier.

Old Turkish Railway Station Museum.

Abrahams well city.

Overnight Arad Guest House

DAY 16 WEDNESDAY 1ST NOVEMBER

Arad Fountain of Tears - artist's dialogue of suffering between Jesus' seven last statements before His death and WWII Holocaust survivors. The name comes from Jeremiah 9:1

Yatir Forest – See the plaque and trees planted to honour Aboriginal Australian William Cooper who led the only known private protest worldwide against Kristallnacht, the start of the Holocaust in 1938. He has a plaque and trees in the Martyrs Forest near Jerusalem also.

Dead Sea float if time.

Sderot – see the bullet holes in this city near the border with Gaza and pray.

Ashdod, visit pastor. Ashdod was allotted to the tribe of Judah. After capturing the Ark of the Covenant from the Israelites, the Philistines took it to Ashdod and placed it in the temple of Dagon.

Overnight: Tel Aviv

DAY 17 THURSDAY 2ND NOVEMBER

Morning – rest, shopping or swim in the Mediterranean Sea.

Afternoon - anniversary of Balfour Declaration in Tel Aviv, light and sound show.

Overnight: Tel Aviv

DAY 18 FRIDAY 3RD NOVEMBER

See ANZAC sites Tel Aviv and Jaffa/Yafo and hear of the 3 battles that took place there.

Visit a pastor in Jaffa. It is the oldest seaport in the world where Jonah, told by God to go to Nineveh instead flees from "the presence of the Lord" going to Jaffa or Joppa and sailing to Tarshish, the opposite direction.

DAY 18 FRIDAY 3RD NOVEMBER CONTINUED

Visit a pastor in Netanya, a seaside tourist town and have a swim.

Overnight: Tel Aviv

DAY 19 SATURDAY 4TH NOVEMBER

Transfer to the airport in good time for your flight on Cathay Pacific home via Hong Kong.

Cathay flight CX674 departs Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport at 12.45pm lunchtime.

Check-in will be required three hours' prior to scheduled departure at 9.45am.

BACKGROUND

Walkabout Zion (Ps 48:12), walk where Jesus or Yeshua walked, pray on the borders of Israel, meet local congregations, Jew and Arab.

We will be praying at Abraham's well and Tel Sheva in Beer Sheva, Gerar, the Tomb of the Patriarchs in Hebron and all the places that God made covenant with Abraham and/or he built altars to the Lord - Mt Hermon, Beth El, Schechem, Hebron & the Temple Mount. Not many tours do this but this tour is very strategic so don't miss out. We will visit sites re William Cooper, Aboriginal Australian, honoured by Yad Vashem.

We will attend the 100th anniversary of the Balfour Declaration by the British Parliament supporting a Jewish homeland in Palestine. It is in Tel Aviv 2 Nov and will be attended by the President and Prime Minister of Israel. We visit strategic ANZAC locations throughout Israel including Jaffa/Yafo, Rishon LeZion, Nes Ziona, Armageddon, Allenby Bridge, the ANZAC trail from Gaza to Beer Sheva and cemeteries in Haifa, Mt Scopus & Beer Sheva. In Semakh and Jerusalem we will connect with ALHA events.
